

HARBORCREEK TOWNSHIP RECYCLING PROGRAM

COMMERCIAL - INSTITUTIONAL - EDUCATIONAL ESTABLISHMENTS

The Harborcreek Township Supervisors are again pleased to congratulate the Harborcreek businesses and the institutional and educational establishments for their commitment to recycling.

The requirements by which you must recycle have not changed. Each establishment, at a minimum, must recycle high-grade office paper, corrugated paper, aluminum, glass, plastics, and leaf waste. Recognizing the environmental and economic benefits associated with recycling, you may wish to include additional materials with your own program.

In order to satisfy state regulations, the Township requires that each commercial, institutional and educational establishment file a recycling report annually, which will be mailed to you at the end of each year.

In order to comply with state requirements, recyclable tonnages are to be verified by either weight receipts or hauler certification. Therefore, please request that your hauler/recycler verify your recyclable tonnages on company letterhead, a copy of which should accompany this report. The name, address and phone number of your private hauler/recycler is important, because if you are unable to provide the amount of materials recycled, we can contact them for the information.
